**Sub: Objection for trying to fix fee in the name of regulation & request to extend the date for filling objection by facilitating English version of Notification draft of PGC 31 2019 dated 21-01-2019.**

The fee regulation for '**private unaided institutions**'; as you are aware is in clear violation of our constitutional protections; and therefore are void and unenforceable, as you have been miss - led, by said issue, confining it to the institutions that are set up / managed by the Government and such unaided private institutions on whom such control is permissible /can be exercised.

Considering all of our observation with fee regulations and the pendency of Karnataka Education Act in the Division Bench of High Court, Karnataka in WP No:23407-09/1995 and several disputes within the Education Act, the High Court in it order dated 26-11-2012 in WP No 18809, 18840/2012, has also permitted the managements to collect the fee as they have prescribed, similar order were made even in WP No 21825/2014 (EDN- RES) on 13-06-2014.

The new draft PGC 31 2019 is again raiding on the same matter with few not implacable versions such as fixing percentage for different defined area such as BBMP, CMC, Etc. and also indirectly fixing Normative expenditure to not exceed with the total Salary and few components of the entire staff is not acceptable where in government is trying to rigidly fixing in the name of regulation.

**The Draft is also in only Kannada version, we request to make available of its English version too, so that the interpretation between Kannada and English shall not be changed and would be better to understand ourself.**
