Subject:-Reconsider to issue permission to English 6-8 / High School.

Reference:- Your office letter / Notice No: _____ dated: _____.

I am here with briefing the court matter which was filed by **Associated Managements of Private Primary and High Schools in Karnataka [KAMS]** bearing W.P.No.55106/2014 and **Karnataka State Private Schools Management Federation** W.P No. 55713/2014., in which the Honourable High court of Karnataka directed to issue Registration Certificate to impart Education in English Medium for First to Fifth Standard & First to Seventh Standard respectively. Above Judgment clearly clarified that Government of Karnataka notification dated 11-11-2014 does not applicable to the existing schools and applicable to only category of Schools proposed to be started from the academic year 2015-16 onwards. This part of judgment not only applies to First to Seventh Standard but also to all the School prior to 2015-16 which were commenced and are running under natural growth. As our required standard grows, we approached the education department timely to accord permission; the applications were rejected dated _____. Along with the proposal for 1-5 English medium, we have also submitted **6-7/8 / High School. [9th and 10th Std]** proposal for permission. As on this day the management has learnt that English Medium 1 to 5thStd is already finalized and issue of relevant conversion certificate in form 4 is awaited.

(If High School proposal rejected)

Registration of 6th to 8th Std English Medium Proposal is under process which is also the disputed matter of language policy,

At this juncture, we being old existing school on natural growth are running the school; our management is in receipt of notice from _____

_____ directing, to close down the **6-7/8 /High School. (9th and 10th Std)** within the stipulated time or otherwise criminal proceedings will be intimated against the management which is bad precedent, as we have submitted proposal during the month _____ for **6-7/8 /High School. (9th and 10th Std)**, your office since from last eight months no process, no objection, nothing initiative is taken, and is not intimated regarding delay before the commencement of academic, after the commencement of academic year under natural growth, now dated _____ notice is served to the Management.

It is well known that the schools starts in the last week of May and Admission to High School concludes on the last day of June.

It is very clear in anticipation of the favorable orders towards from your department, we have enrolled the students and sudden directions from your office to close down our said class and send the students to the nearby Schools, is against the trust of the management with the education department. It is well known that Department fixes the Last day to receive the proposals, but there is no date fixture towards finalization of proposals before the starting of the academic year which confuses, the part of department's responsibility.

Necessary Infrastructures and all other arrangements were taken for the enrolled students as per the old norms, as we are old existing school, with the teaching faculty and other basic needs, If the closure initiative is taken, it creates anarchy among the parents and trouble the education to student with financial burdening, it also burdens budget school management and budget class families. This step also leads to curtail the rights of parents to educate their respective wards for continuity of education in one institution, which is a healthy trend.

Under all the above circumstances, I request you once again, in the interest of continuity of enrolled students' education; registration of our school be reconsidered and issued notice towards closure of school may be withdrawn.
