Sub:- Regarding Submission of Audit Report to release first and second instalment RTE reimbursement amount.

It is well known to your good self in the last academic year RTE reimbursement amount was released on the basis of previous respective academic year audit report which was not based on any guidelines in the relevant rules under RTE act 2009.

In the same above said RTE act it is not specified under any rules and sections to release RTE reimbursement amount on the basis of school annual audited report and will consider only recurring expenditure and non recurring and deprecation will be not refunded, it means the expenditure occurred in these category is either not collected by rest 75% of the students as they don't agree to pay. and

Keeping all these facts, we request you to consider the Fee collected from rest of 75% students or pay recurring and non recurring both calculated and divide per child to arrive per child expenditure for reimbursement. If not considered, We being the member bearing registered number _____ of KAMS, we state that, our management association (**Associated Management of Private Schools in Karnataka – KAMS**) has filed **Writ Petition – W.P. No. 58873 of 2015 (EDN-RES), IA 5 of 2016** in the **Honorable High Court of Karnataka** in which praying to Quash the Audited Report to release the RTE reimbursement amount. (Government of Karnataka notification Dt. 08-02-2016) which is pending.

Under these circumstances, I the undersigned am intimating your good self, the question of submitting Audited report does not arise and awaiting the above court Judgment in our favour.

I request your office to take necessary steps to release the instalments of RTE, reimbursement as per rest 75 % calculation of respective standard, government has to pay immidiately to feed the financial crunch & reduce the burden which is already being borne by the School Management.
